


If you are **going into CALCULUS** in the fall of 2018, the Summer Assignment will be on Delta Math **after August 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>** under Prof. Lin's teacher code.

If you've been A2 student this year in CSS, you already have a Delta Math account. You just need to switch your teacher. Here's how:

1. Log in to your account and go to "Tools"
  2. Click "Manage and Login Teachers", and then "Add Teacher"
  3. Screen will have a blank for a Teacher Code.
  4. Enter: **859294** in the blank for Teacher Code.
  5. In Assignments, you'll see "Summer Assignment 1 and 2 on the respective dates".

If you don't have a Delta Math account, you need to create one:

1. Go to [www.deltamath.com](http://www.deltamath.com)

2. Click **Create Account**. (for Student)
3. Enter Teacher Code: **859294**, and **Ms. Lin** should pop up, along with blank fields for Student and Login information.
4. Select that you are in the "Calculus Summer Assignment."
5. Fill out the student information using your CSS email, and make a password.
6. Click **Create Account**.
7. You should then see "Summer HW for incoming Calculus students".

The assignment is **due at 8am Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup>**. When you've completed the required number of problems in a topic, Delta Math does NOT automatically move you to the next problem set. It's up to the student to see when they've completed enough of that section, and start a new topic.
